The nominating committee of the MTMIC Board will announce the slate for the Board of Directors election on August 15, 2008 and the ballots will be mailed to policyholders on September 2, 2008. The deadline for the return of your ballot is September 15, 2008 for your vote to be counted.

The newly elected Directors will be announced at the October 16, 2008 Annual Meeting being held this year at the Red Run Golf Course. The term for Directors runs from January 1 through December 31 and each term is three years in length.

This year's election is important because one of the long standing Directors is not seeking reelection this year as his family business has taken on a new opportunity which requires all of his time and talents.

The Board meets on the morning of the third Thursday of each month to oversee, discuss and direct the operations of the MTMIC. Most meetings are held in the offices of the TMTA at 28237 Orchard Lake Road, Farmington Hills, MI 48333-9150.
